- SuFu & the City, Madrid '10: main topics => urban planning, sustainable architecture, active citizenship, solar energy, waste management, sustainable cities
- Danube the most international river in the world, Bratislava '10: participants explored the international character of the Danube river and its influences on societies around it
- Danube source of inspiration, Danube Delta '10: main activities study trips to forest and lakes, garbage clean up day at beach, workshops about sustainability and nature conservation, presentation about Danube Delta and the river's influence on artists, boat trip on the Danube

- Shake the planet in Sofia '10, agora preevent: organized by AEGEE-Sofia, together with DWG and EnWG and topic for the EnWG workshops was BIODIVERSITY in the framework of 2010 International Year of Biodiversity
- Energy project in Magdeburg '09 : organized by AEGEE-Magdeburg and EnWG with support of German Ministry of Education and Science ⇒ topic: How could international collaboration look like to secure ENERGY SUPPLY?
