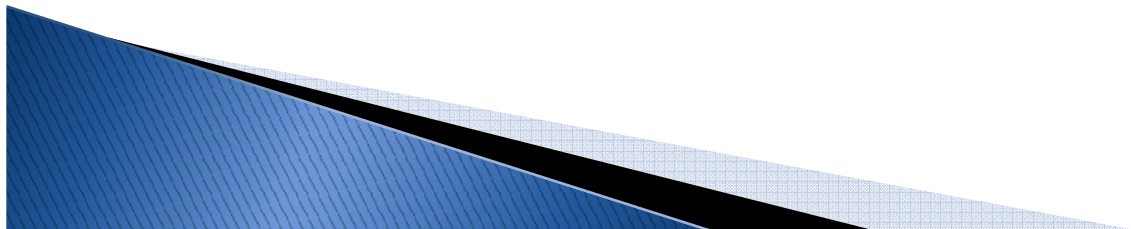
# IPWG and BEYOND EUROPE

- ▶ **Project Development Meeting** (Brussels, 16-20 September);



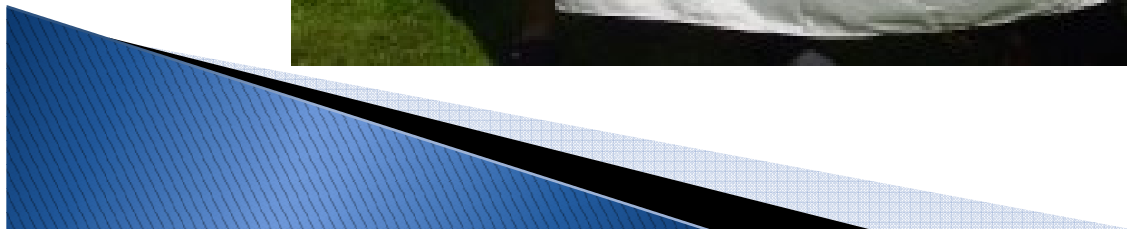
# Youth in the World

- ▶ UN Millennium Development Goals – A Challenge for Today's Youth?, (Pillar of Beyond Europe, India and South Africa);

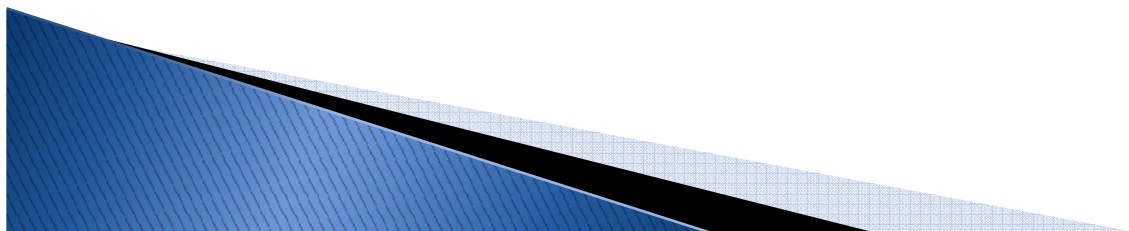

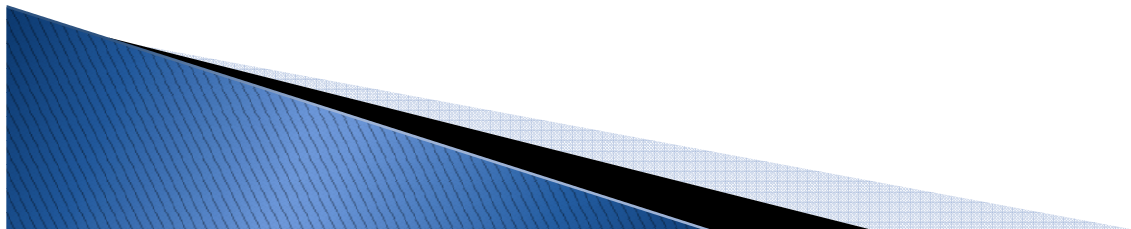

The UN nuclear chief gives Iran, the US, France and Russia a draft deal aimed at easing concerns over Tehran's nuclear plans.

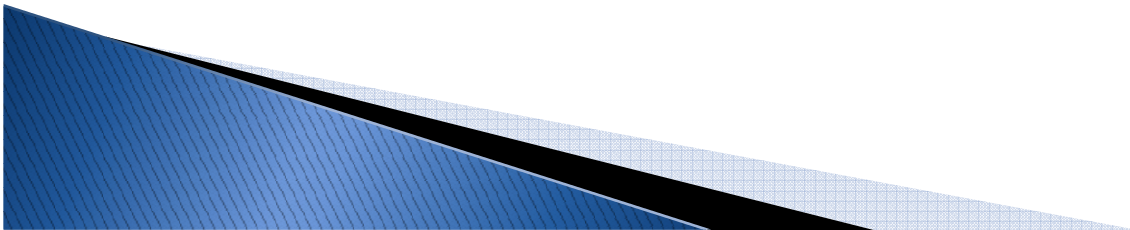
**Terror suspect arrested in Boston**
